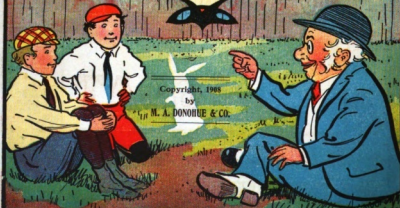

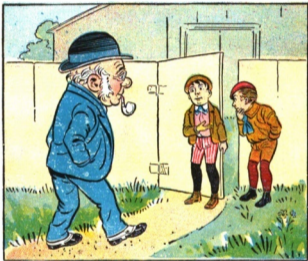

## The Boys Show Him Their New Goat.



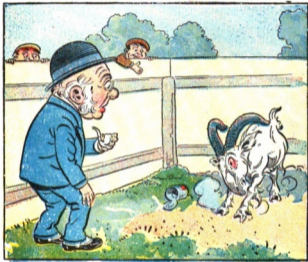
**“Come and ride our goat, dear Grandpa,

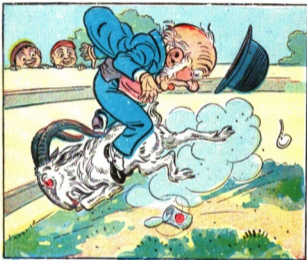
**“He’s a gentle little creature

With a fierce look in his eye.**

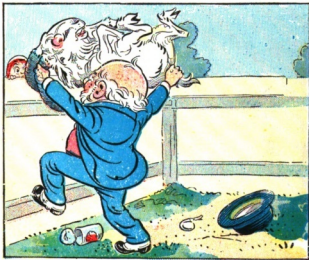
## The Boys Show Him Their New Goat.

With a very sudden glide.**

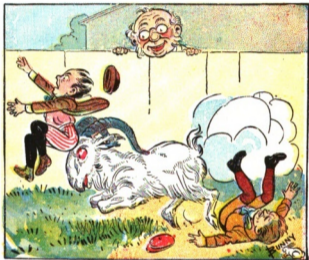

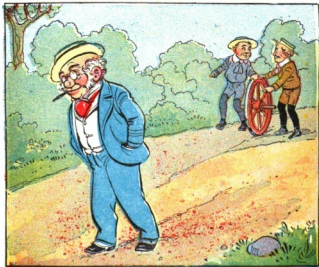
**“If he’s so playful,” said Grandpa,

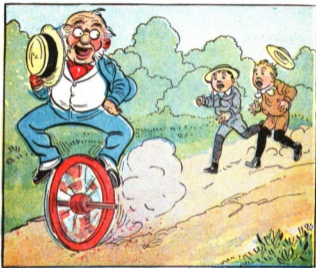
**“Look out,” cried the boys thoughtfully,

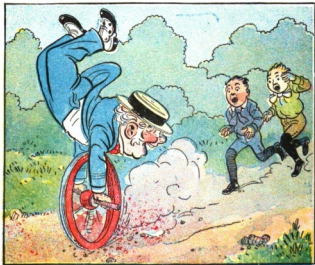
**But Foxy Grandpa's very tricky,

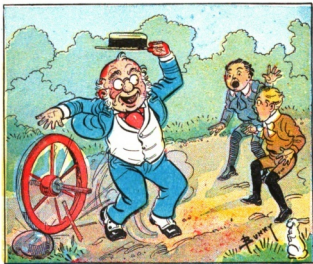
In jumping up on top the wheel

Grandpa just got off in time.

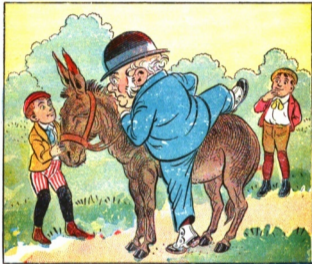

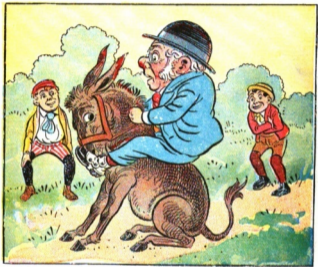
**“Come, take a ride, dear Grandpa,

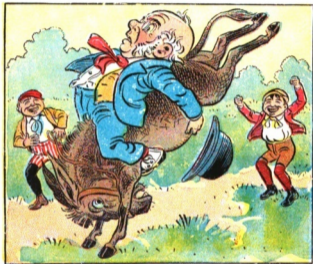
**“Well, I will take a chance, boys,

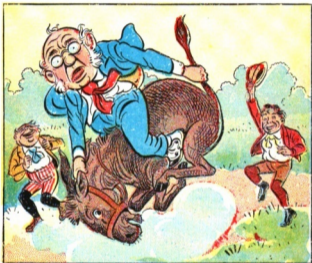
**Now Grandpa's fairly mounted

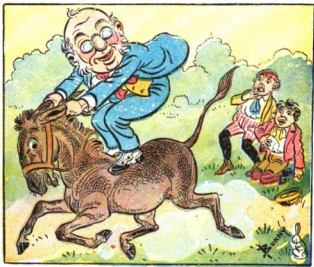
**Then as he gives an awful kick

And on pleasure bent.**

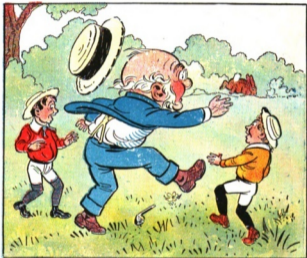

"Before he gets too shy."

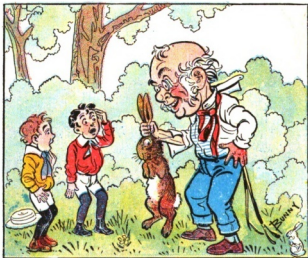
