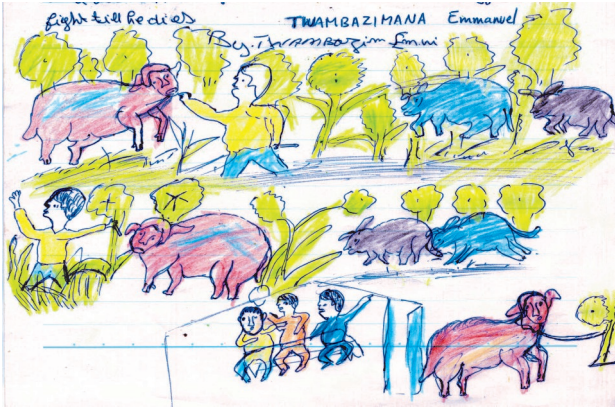


# Be a Good Shepherd
