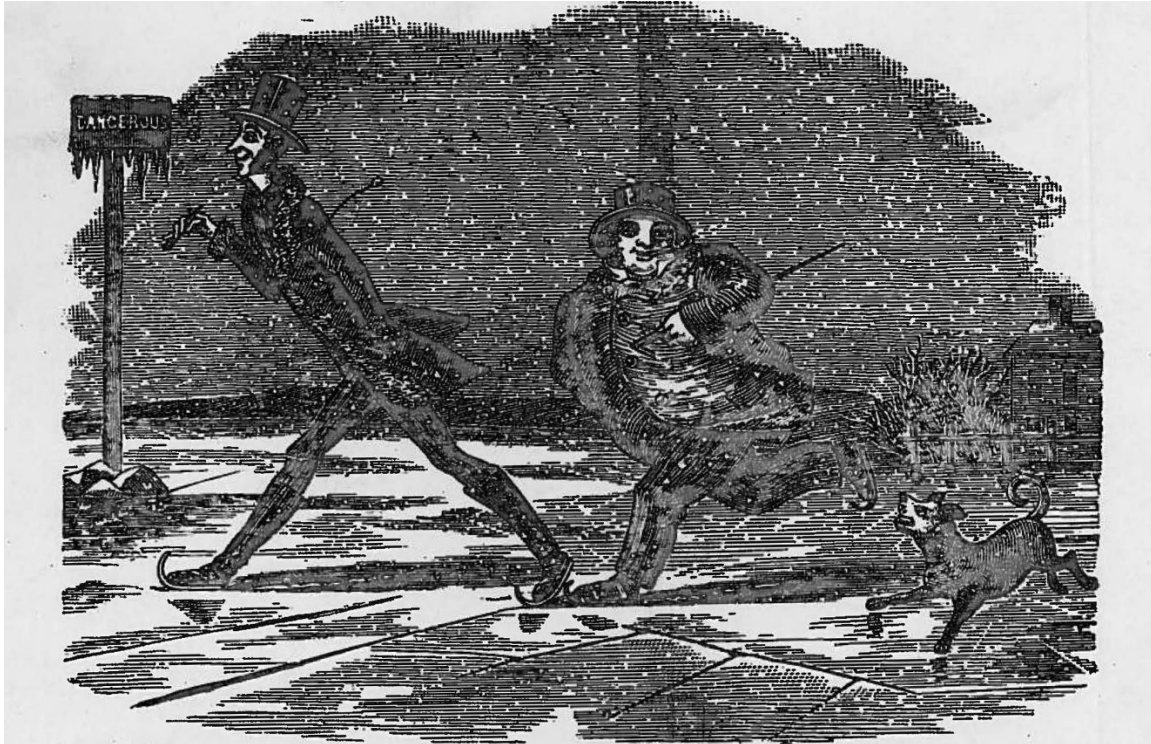

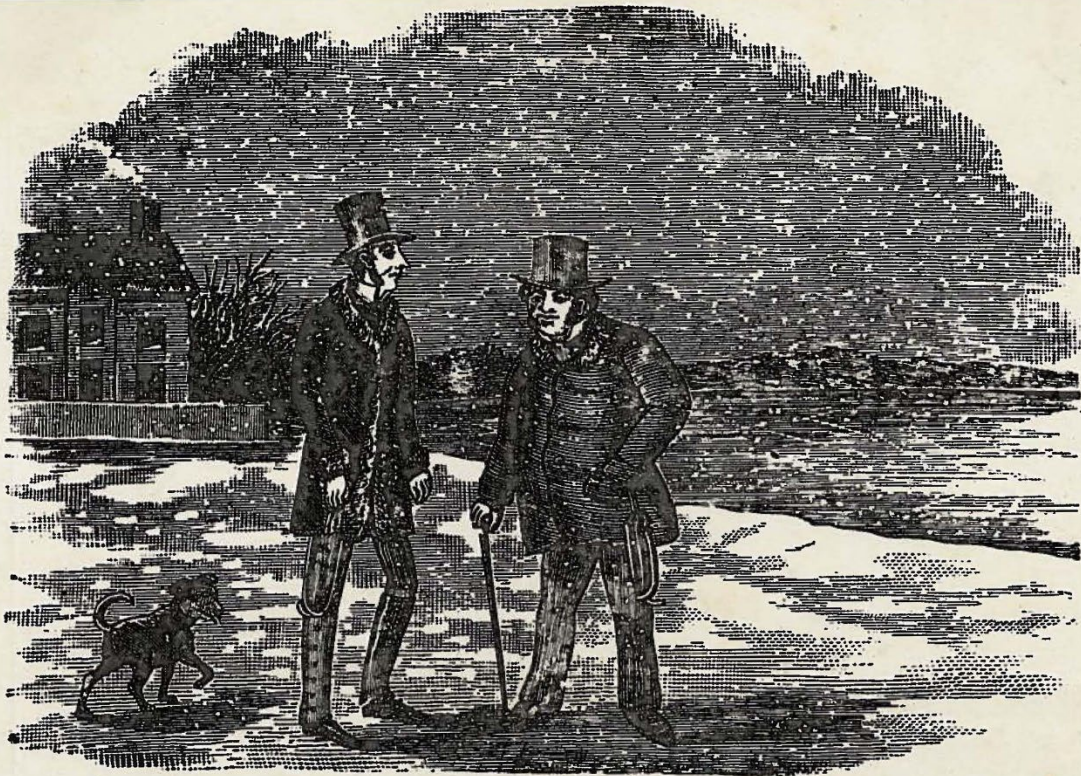

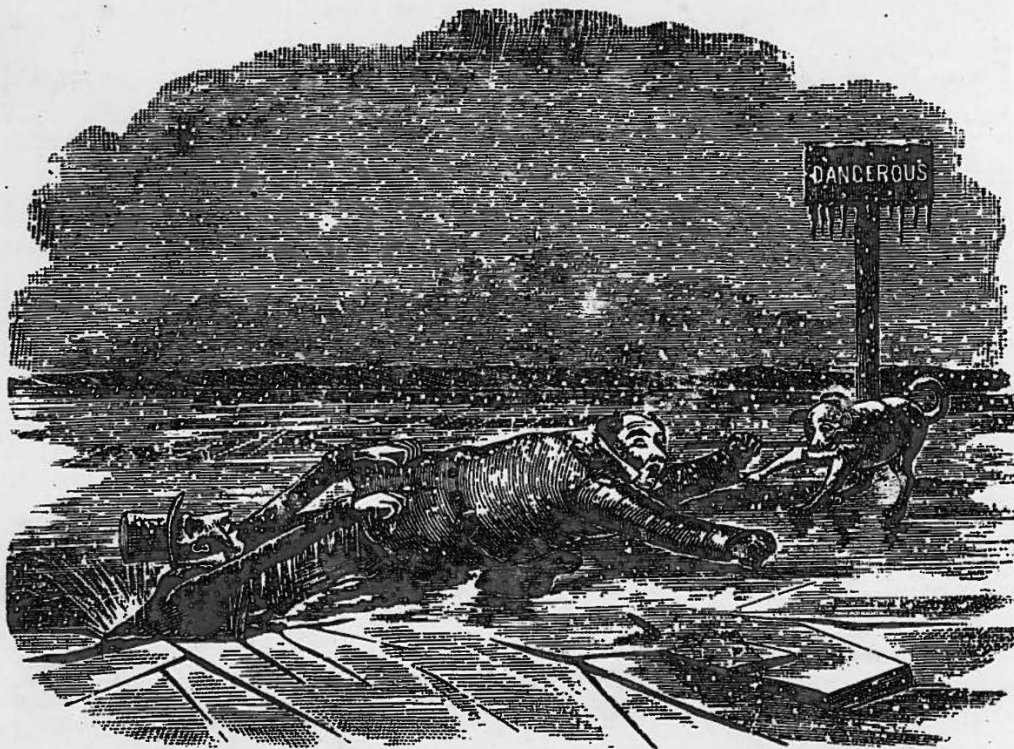
MR. SKINNER'S AND MR. TROTTER'S SKATING EXPERIENCES.

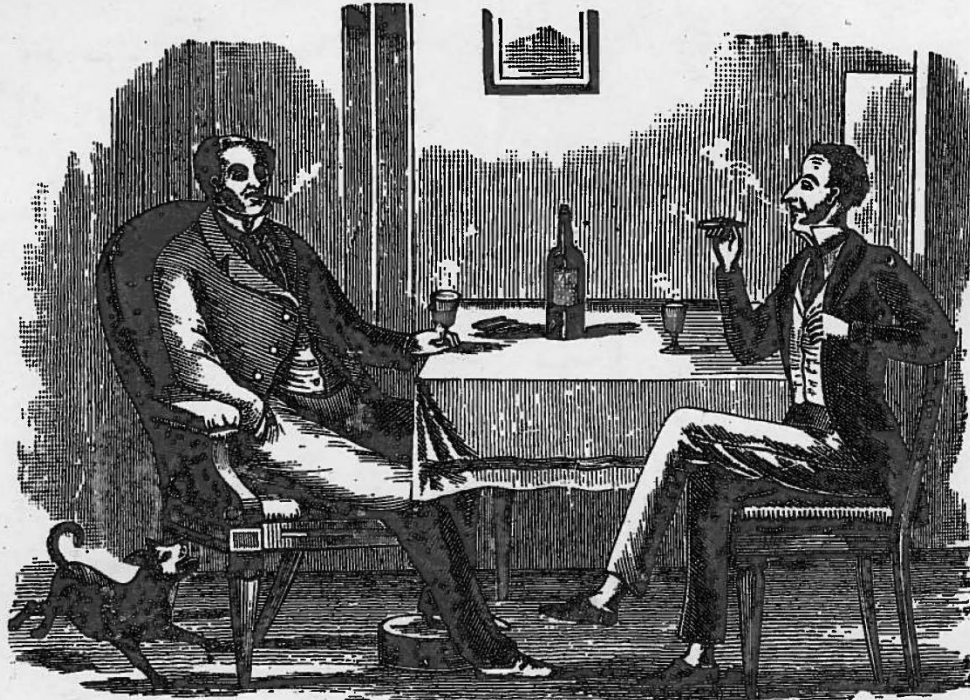
MR. SKINNER'S AND MR. TROTTER'S SKATING EXPERIENCES.
