Furthermore, as the head of our republic noted, “We are all witnessing the drastic changes taking place in the world today. The active introduction of advanced technologies and the development of the global information and communication space are rapidly changing all processes, serving to develop new forms of cooperation at the level of continents, regions, countries and business. In the principle of “struggle for human mind and heart”, the relationship between ideas and consciousness is expressed on the basis of Eastern philosophical thinking. An idea becomes a call to action, a motivating force, a guide for activity only when it occupies the heart of a person through the mind, becomes an integral part of a person’s spiritual and spiritual condition. Therefore, today, adherence to this principle forms the core of the ideological struggle.
