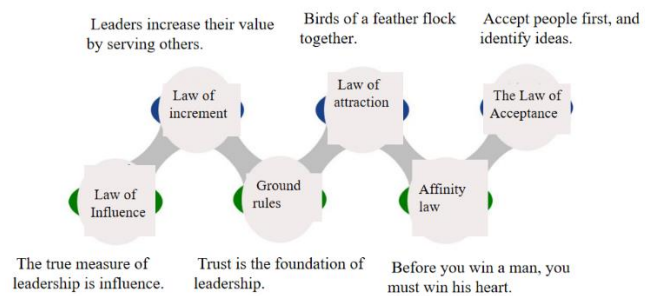


Figure 1. Elements of leadership

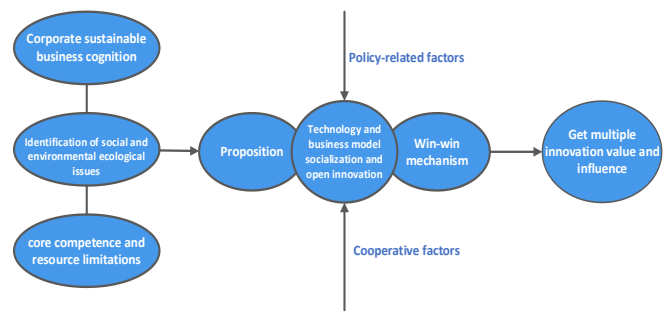


Figure 2. Strategy execution capability

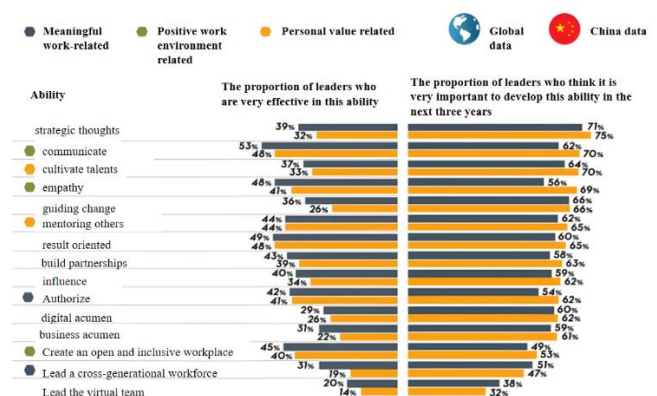


Figure 3. Global leadership forecast for 2023
