



SOCIAL CULTURE AND PERSONAL SUCCESS

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Abstract: This article covers the topic of social culture and personal success. In this theory, it is emphasized that the development of the individual takes place through various social contexts, particularly micro- and macrosystems (Bronfenbrenner, 1979). Also, research conducted by James Coleman sheds light on the role of the educational system in the formation of social capital and its impact on personal success (Coleman, 1988).

Edgar Schein's *"Organizational Culture and Leadership"* is one of the primary sources for studying the impact of organizational culture on individual success. Schein shows how culture is formed in organizations and how it can be managed through leadership (Schein, 1985). This approach is especially important in ensuring professional success.

5. Mass Media

Marshall McLuhan's *"Understanding Media: The Extensions of Man"* is noteworthy regarding the influence of mass media. According to McLuhan's theory, the media is not only a means of information transmission, but also one of the main factors that shape people's worldview and behavior (McLuhan, 1964). At the same time, the issue of the spread of culture through new media and social networks and its impact on personal success also remains relevant.

6. Globalization and Intercultural Relations

Intercultural relations in the process of globalization and their impact on personal success should be highlighted. Appadurai examines the role of cultural flows in globalization and their impact on personal identity (Appadurai, 1996), while Robertson examines how globalization affects local cultural processes (Robertson, 1992).
