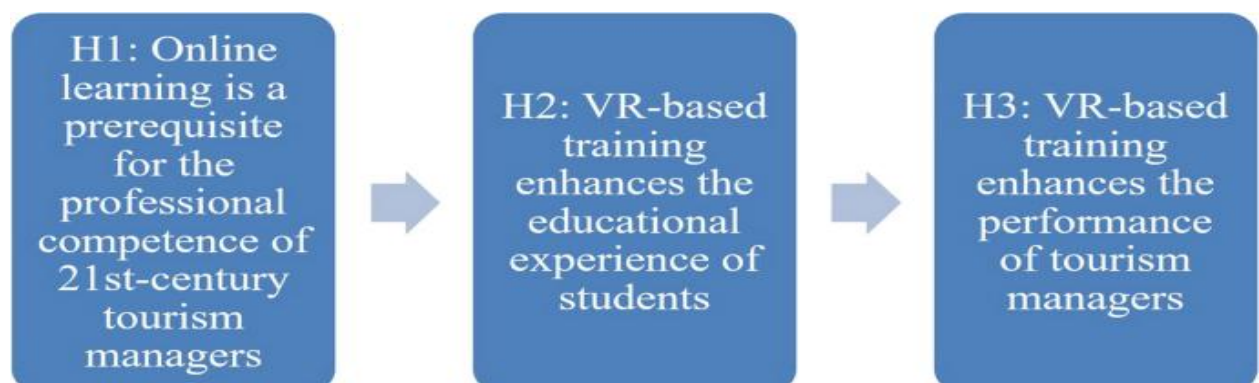
through social media and audiovisual content, aiming to ensure continuous interaction with tourists through virtual communication. This allows offering the traditional visiting experience in a remote and interactive format.

1-figure. Grouping of research carried out on the example of the ATLAS platform.



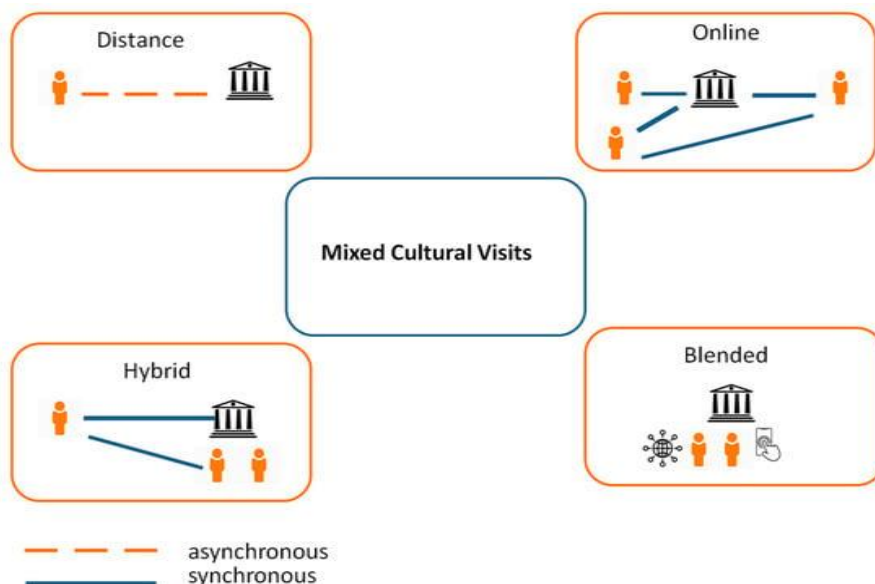
#### Innovative Applications of Digital Technologies in Tourism Marketing
