- A presentation of the book “New Uzbekistan: The Path of Shavkat Mirziyoyev” took place in the U.S. Congress.
- The event aimed to share insights about the ongoing reforms in Uzbekistan, the country’s political course, and future strategies with American political and expert circles.
- A book discussion with the participation of U.S. Congress members, experts, and journalists was also held, where Uzbekistan’s current potential and reforms were presented.

- The visit strengthens Uzbekistan’s strategic position in Central Asia. Productive dialogue with the United States opens new opportunities for cooperation in regional security, water management, and energy issues.
- It also amplifies Uzbekistan’s voice in addressing global challenges such as climate change, ecology, and sustainable development.
