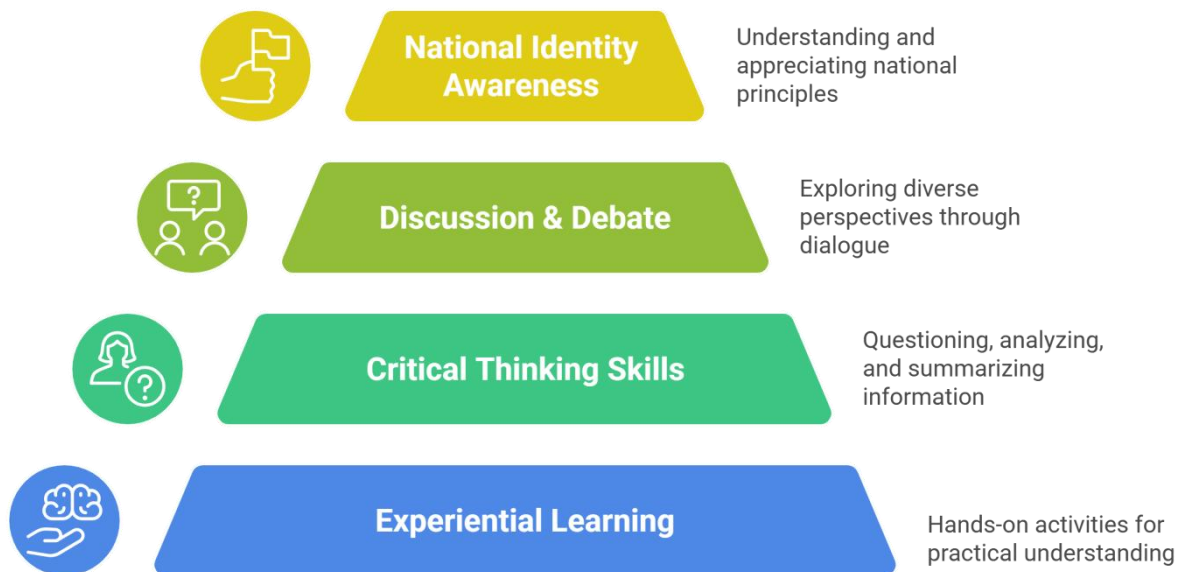

Critical Thinking Development Pyramid

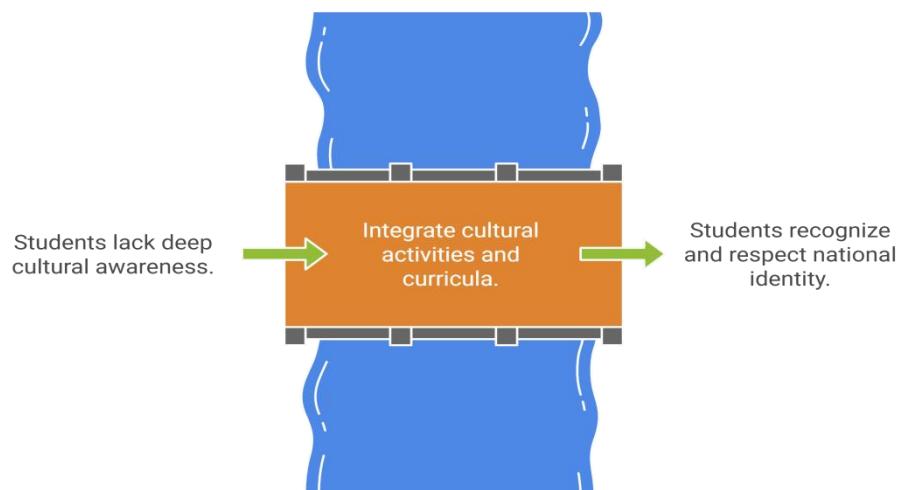


resources for collaborative partnerships between schools and local organizations, facilitating opportunities to students to engage in service projects that reflect national values and social responsibilities.
