

NEW VOCATIONAL HORTICULTURE CURRICULUM

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As result of an increasing demand for teachers of Vocational Horticulture in Ohio, a committee of representatives of the departments of agricultural education and horticulture have recommended a revised curriculum for preparing such teachers. The revised curriculum provides 30 to 40 credit hours in the horticulture area and about 20 quarter hours in other technical agriculture areas.

Students must take a minimum of 30 quarter hours of professional work in agricultural education to meet certification requirements. Students may major either in horticulture or in agriculture education and pursue essentially the same program.
