

CURRICULUM EVALUATION STUDY

A study has just been completed dealing with an analysis of the significant activities engaged in at M.S.U. in the Teacher Education Program for preparing teachers of vocational agriculture. The investigation was a part of a three year state-wide investigation of vocational education in Michigan. A committee composed of teachers of vocational agriculture, local high school administrators, a high school counselor, several members of the faculty of the College of Agriculture and the College of Education, together with several members of the State Office Consultant Staff in agricultural education worked on the project.

Facts ascertained will be further analyzed and researched with the ultimate aim of bringing about desirable changes in the teacher education program in agriculture where facts warrant such changes.
