

TEACHER EDUCATION YOUNG FARMERS CLASS

A young farmers' class is sponsored by the Montana State College Department of Teacher Education in Agriculture. Enrollments approximate thirty with an average attendance of twenty-two. The group includes agriculture business representatives. Frequent attenders are trainees in agricultural education. The program serves largely to keep teacher educators in touch with farmer problems and acquaint trainees with adult education. Meetings start with a noon luncheon in the Student Union and last till 3 p.m. to permit class members to get home for the farm chores. Class programs feature farm tours and use of resource teachers.
