We offer them extraordinary greeting upon their appearance as a signal as well as out of regard and respect for their obligation."

Anupriya, one of the specialists treating COVID-19 patients at LNJP Hospital, has not returned home for five days. She revealed to India Today that her video-call with her significant other turns into a passionate trade. "My family is worried about me yet they all are steady. My better half has gotten the hang of cooking," said Dr Anupriya. and her better half will praise their wedding commemoration in an irregular manner. "My significant other revealed to me that we would slice the cake online to commend our wedding commemoration coming in barely any days," she said engaging her feelings.

"It is my obligation to deal with my patients and furthermore keep myself and my family protected. By not returning home, I am guaranteeing that my family isn't tainted through me," Dr. Anupriya said.

Dr. Kapil, whose family remains in Maharashtra, stated, "My folks ring me from Nagpur a few times. In any case, I am not ready to accept their calls. Shrouded in close to home defensive hardware, I can't go to their calls while on the job. Family is stressed over us yet our obligation is pre-eminent and past any dread."

Another specialist, Dr Manish too has not returned home for a considerable length of time. He said his folks have been helpful urging him to play out his obligation well during this pandemic. There have been reports that a portion of the corona virus patients have acted boisterous with specialists in the LNJP Hospital. Reacting to such reports, Dr. Anupriya stated, "The COVID-19 patients are confronting troublesome circumstances. The highest per cent of respondents i.e. 53.5% are strongly agree that complete lockdown will help to fight against Covid-19. Further, 20.5% of respondents are agreed with the fact that complete lockdown will help to fight against Covid-19 for the whole country. However, only 10% of respondents are disagree respectively.

The highest per cent of respondents i.e. 40% are strongly agree that management and government are providing required equipments. Complete. Further, 40% of respondents are agreed with the same fact. However, only 12.5% of respondents are disagreeing respectively.

The highest per cent of respondents i.e. 35.5% are agree that they feel quite nervous while performing their duty as their families are connected with them. Further, 28.5% of respondents are strongly agreed with the given statement. However, only 17.5% of respondents are disagreeing respectively.

The highest per cent of respondents i.e. 32% are strongly agree. Further, 31.5% of respondents are agreed. However, only 15.5% of respondents are disagreeing respectively.

RESULT:

handshaking, Stay home and stay Safe, We all must follow all precautions, to avoid this, Government has to provide enough tools to hospitals and Information to normal people to fight with covid19, Stay home stay safe, Maintain social distancing and Use all preventive measures, Hope and patience, Continue lockdown till cases will down to Zero, Stay home stay safe, Please do not be overwhelmed with covid 19's thoughts, keep distance, Provide more information to everyone, reduce fake news and provide proper facilities in hospitals and open all private hospital and treat all patients as a civil hospital by private hospital during these days, We all must follow all precautions, to avoid this, Complete lockdown, social distance is very necessary, Social distancing is the best solution, I would like to suggest the government that please provide equipments to the medical personals such as PPE kit so, that they can also protect themselves from getting infected with virus and provide them separate rooms to them so that they can work more enthusiastically and another things is that high authorities should fulfil the basic needs of the low income groups, This situation is going to need a team effort coming from our side. If we continue to do all these idiotic things we are doing, time shall come when everything will go against us.
