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Registration for the 4th International Evidence Based Library and Information Practice (EBLIP4) is open. The final day for registration at the reduced rate is April 9, 2007.

The conference on May 6-9, 2007 in Chapel Hill-Durham, North Carolina, will feature themed sessions on evidence-based practice in academic libraries, school library media, healthcare, special libraries, and evidence-based methodology. Two days of continuing
