For U.K. Librarians, the Library and Information Research Group (LIRG) has recently announced:

- A new Research Prize for £2,500, sponsored by Ex Libris, for library systems-based research.
- A new <u>LIRG Researcher Directory</u> listing library research practitioners in the U.K. The Directory is keyword searchable and can be browsed by research topic.

  Researchers can enter their own name, under multiple topics if need

- be, and are encouraged to do so if they have a work-based interest in research.
