Be sure to tell the Priest How Many Times you have committed a sin.



Jesus, I am Sorry for my Sins. -68-

In the Confessional

Say to the Priest, "Bless me Father, for I have sinned. It has been weeks (or months) since my last Confession." (Tell your sins and the number of times you have committed each sin.)

After telling your sins, say: "For these and all the sins of my past life, especially for . . . (mention some sin you confessed before) I am truly sorry."

Then listen to the penance the Priest gives you and say the following Act of Contrition:

An Act of Contrition

O MY God, I am heartily sorry for having offended Thee and I detest all my sins, because of Thy just punishments, but most of all because they offend Thee, my God, Who art all-good and deserving of all my love.

I firmly resolve, with the help of Thy grace, to sin no more and to avoid the near occasions of sin. Amen.

AFTER CONFESSION

Before anything else, say the penance the Priest gave you. Then say:

J ESUS, You have taken away all my sins.

With this pure
soul of mine
I wish to live
for You alone,
only to obey You,
only to please You.

I am happy now because my soul is at peace.

I will thank Jesus for taking my sins away.

JESUS, I thank You for taking my sins away.

Help me to keep my soul free from sin.

May I never hurt You again.

Be a good winner.




